IT IS on this 19th day of June 2009, hereby **ORDERED**:

1. By no later than **July 1, 2009**, Defendant shall produce to Plaintiff's counsel all data pertaining to Plaintiff, Carol Bell, that is contained in the "LM People" and "LM Careers" databases.

2. By no later than **July 8, 2009**, Defendant shall identify a person or persons with knowledge about Defendant's "LM People" software program, and by no later than **July 17, 2009**, Defendant shall "identify a person or persons with knowledge about [Defendant's] information management systems, including computer-based and other digital systems, with the ability to facilitate, through counsel, reasonably anticipated discovery," as set forth in Local Civil Rule 26.1(d)(1).
3. The Court will continue the initial conference in this matter by telephone on **July 30, 2009** at **2:30 P.M.**. Counsel for Plaintiff shall initiate the telephone call. By no later than **July 28, 2009**, counsel shall submit to the Court a letter setting forth proposed revisions to the joint discovery plan.
